Please send this PHAA Filing Form in as early as summer before 9th grade.

Your evaluator cannot prepare your PHAA transcript until you have joined.

I am the Supervisor of a Home Education Program in Pennsylvania, and have decided to join PHAA and open a file for my student at this time. I understand that, until my student graduates, I will be a PHAA member with voting privileges, and my student will receive a subscription to the high school student newsletter, *The Excelsior*.

Enclosed are the following:

___ If the student attended a school between 9th and 12th grades, I have asked the school to send to PHAA official sealed copies his or her transcript.

___ Copies of evaluation letters for each year of high school at home so far, if any.

___ \$45 filing fee made payable to PHAA. Fee doubled if postmarked in July (after the student graduated).

Filing Forms are not accepted in August or after (after the student graduated; our students graduate in June or before).

I understand that PHAA will send an embossed copy of this transcript (with evaluation letters attached) to a prospective college or employer if PHAA receive a request to do so signed by myself or my student and accompanied by a transcript fee.
